

Earth Look

We know what Earth looks like - the blind excepted - and we're fascinated with descriptions of Heaven. What does Earth look like, **from** Heaven? What do our Guardian Angel Guides (GAGs) see and what do we see? For example, before and after incarnating? How does the human Earth environment look?

Q: What does Earth look like from Heaven?

C: You are already in Heaven, simply look around yourself.

Q: We have a field of vision and can see about 180° around ourselves, give or take (mostly take) but we can't see in the dark very well and we also cannot look directly at the sun. Focus is an issue for some of us, contact lenses, eyeglasses, sunglasses are a big business. What do we see in spirit that's different?

C: You see just what you do now, and other things if you wish.

Q: I wish to see inside a rock.

C: You may.

Q: How?

C: Stone and all dense matter in the environment of Earth and many other environments inside the physical existence humans see, the entirety of the galaxy and universe you perceive, have an energy signature or profile. This emits light human bodies are unable to process. Free from the limits of light frequencies inherent to human beings, all things are visible.

Q: If our Guardian Angel Guides come for a hike in the desert with us, do they see the rocks, their insides or the surfaces of them?

C: Both or either, depending on choice. We suggest it operates much as might a computer application and display. Different levels can be included, made more opaque or intense, or excluded.

Q: When our GAGs see us going about our activities, do we appear differently than what another human would see?

C: No.

Q: What about behind ourselves?

C: Your GAGs, and in this case we are yours, can immediately and instantly see 360° as might be displayed in a panoramic photograph pasted to the walls of a circular chamber in which you would stand. There is a slight delay as you physically turn, which does not affect us. We can see the entire surrounding view at once, if we wish.

Q: How about up and down?

C: We can see this completely, also.

Q: So it's like the inside of a sphere?

C: Yes.

Q: Do Earth and the environment look unusual?

C: To the unprepared it might, however this is overcome nearly immediately, as might look a new town to a human who has never travelled there. To view a new environment is simply a new view added to the base of knowledge and experience.

Q: Let's say one of you is not inside a human environment; what surrounds you?

C: Whatever we create or choose to see at that moment.

Q: Being my GAGs, when do you not see the human environment I occupy?

C: When you are asleep.

Q: When I fall deep asleep and then wake up without a sensation of time passing, when I have to look at a clock or my watch to then remember when I think I fell asleep, is this an example?

C: Yes, and this applies to all humans. Less so to animals, almost not at all, because animals do not clock time.

Q: Doesn't it get boring, watching your human charge all the "time"?

C: We are your charge. No.

Q: You are my "charge"?

C: Yes, we work for you, obey you, follow your instructions and direction. Ask if you are sometimes bored with your surroundings and then recall the moment the boredom ends, which is generally a sharp break in pattern and rhythm. The sensation of boredom requires the passage of the illusion of time. Because we are not bound by this constraint, we do not feel boredom.

Q: It is not boring for the GAGs of a human in prison?

C: No.

Q: You can create surroundings which duplicate what exists on Earth?

C: Yes, and this is common. We can also add to or enhance the appearance.

Q: Add buildings we do not have or yet?

C: Among other things, yes. We can also change any aspect of the surroundings; the sea can be as green as the sky, the snow as yellow as yellow and we can modify the brick to stone or stucco as we prefer.
