

Γεώργιος Κυριάκος Παναγιώτου



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Georgios Kyriacos Panayiotou, known professionally as George Michael, was a singer, songwriter and record producer who rose to fame as a member of the music duo Wham! In the early 1980s. Born in London the 25th of June, 1963 to a Greek Cypriot father who'd immigrated in the 1950s and an English mother. The recipient of many awards during his 30 year career, Michael sold more than 100 million records worldwide. His debut solo album, *Faith*, sold more than 20 million. Michael achieved seven #1 singles in the UK and eight on the *Billboard* Hot 100 in the USA and ranks among the best-selling British acts of all time. In 2008 he was ranked 40th on *Billboard's* list of the Greatest Hot 100 Artists of All Time.

George Michael died the 25th of December 2016.

GM: Sort of, being that I felt very frustrated with life to the point where I tried to cut it short. I now know I was simply warming up for the big exit already on the schedule.

RQ2: What was the first thing you saw after death ?

GM: My mum.

RQ3: What were you most surprised about ?

GM: How normal and comfortable everything seemed, being so different at the same time. You're supposed to feel a bit put of sorts when you get to a new place, but I understand home in Heaven isn't a new place. It took a minute to recognize everything again, but as soon as I got there, I was calm, cool and comfortable.

RQ4: Does you see hear and feel the emotions of love and appreciation and sorrow from your loved ones and fans or do those strong earthly emotions pull or keep him uncomfortably tied to earth ?

GM: Oh yes, very much I feel them and a lot more than I think I ever could have on Earth. Emotions are intensified compared to Earth, but they're also much better understood at the same time.

There's no tie to Earth emotions or feelings cause; every soul who watches Earth, has lived a life on it or plans to is tied to Earth just the same anyway. There's no link to be cut; it's a permanent connection.

RQ5: Is there anything you think we'd find fascinating about meeting your guides and angels, did they immediately seem familiar ?

GM: There was nothing fascinating at all, it was like meeting your best mates, times two. As soon as I was with everybody, I felt great. Relaxed and welcomed.

RQ6: Does he have any regrets and what is he most proud of ?

GM: I regret not coming out sooner and not being more honest. That's the life lesson I went to tackle, to learn to be honest and not conceal important things. The problem is, a while after you've done it, the people who were in the dark can feel as if they caused you to clam up. They can feel guilty but they are just as likely to keep that quiet, because they don't want to face that.

I am most proud of my success at surviving success; it was a challenge maybe people around me didn't see so much. I got through the years of sudden fame and fortune without a total meltdown. I was also able to be generous and keep that to myself, for the most part. I was just as proud of being able to do that.

Q: Was your life purpose to be a famous singer?

GM: Yes, but not as successful as I became. That went a lot farther than I wrote into the schedule.

Q: There was something in your biography about a brief coma related to severe pneumonia, and when you came out of it, your accent changed to a different part of England. Why?

GM: That old past lives stuff, another life in western England.

Q: *I was in western England about 6 months ago, and I didn't hear a very different accent. I did hear a Welshman who sounded different though, but his age means the formation of his accent pre-dated the television age.*

GM: Hang 'round long enough mate and the accents will come introduce themselves.

Q: *Do you believe the smoking and your lung problems were related?*

GM: Yes, and I made things worse.

Q: *Do you have any regrets besides not coming out sooner?*

GM: No, not at all. I will say, in my own defence, I was evolving and needed to finish that before settling on being one way versus the other, and not a regular combination which is what I thought when I was younger. Like in school.

Q: *Do you have any message(s) for humanity, or just your fans?*

GM: First I have one thing to say to my partner, or boyfriend as you Yanks like to say, which is simply thank you. I hope that gets to him. To my fans, you made me. To humanity, a lot. Have a seat and sip of whatever you're drinking and listen:

Life is far greater thing than it seems most of the time. That's the design; things are supposed to seem a little grey, a little dark once in a while. A touch of sadness or disappointment delivers a point-of-view that constant happiness can't provide, and you're better for it, even if it seems the opposite.

Enjoy your time on Earth and do what excites you.

Q: *One last question; you were born on the 25th and died on the 25th. Any meaning or interpretation to be considered?*

GM: No. The plan of humans lives coming and going, starting and finishing, are usually set close to or spot on the right point, but the calendar date where they end up happening is random. Years, days and months are not used to coordinate, not in Heaven.

Q: *George, thank you for the visit.*

GM: A pleasure mate, come 'round again anytime you like. Bye....
