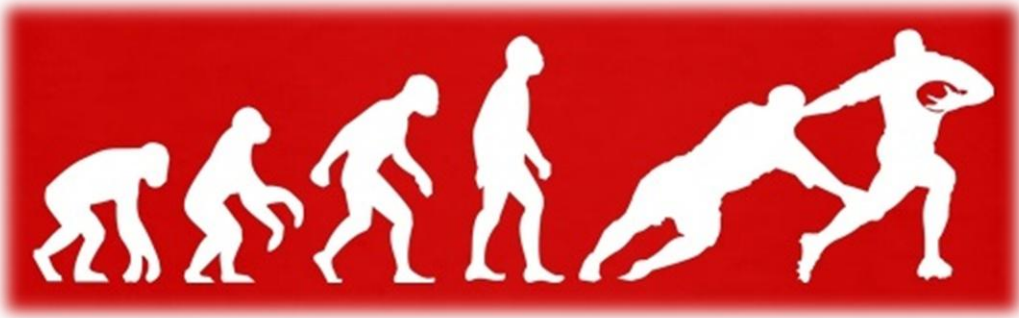


# The Origins of Humans

The Committee says, "The design of the human body is an interesting subject, one we suggest be treated in more depth and willing we are, as the questions are sent. As humans know well, physical stress, impact and repeated use cause damage. The joint damage to which you refer is an example of the limits exceeded. This applies to any physical substance.

The purpose of the creation of the first humanoids was as you ask, physical work. The reasons were atmospheric, principally. The ability to exert force, employ physical strength yet maintain proper body temperature and dissolved respiratory gas was very difficult for the visitors. They did not come with the technology, materials or tools to properly construct equipment and found it far easier to create a species, but which would not disturb the natural social order and existing populations of plants and animals.

Even if manufacture of the necessary equipment were possible, construction of the proper tools and the manufacturing of equipment and structures themselves, would have proved taxing and difficult in the atmosphere of Earth.

Thus local workers, non-existent until created, were developed to serve the purpose.

The general form and upright stature and proportions of the human body derive from the alien ET

visitor portion of the DNA; the first humanoids took other characteristics from the Earth planet source DNA, taken from simians already evolved on Earth.

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Let's begin with reader Kim's questions from above, one-by-one.

*RKQ: Was the outer genitalia originally more from simian DNA or the et visitors- considering much of the general physical form was from the et visitors?*

C: We discuss the issue of DNA mixing, manipulation and blending. Human capability cannot yet extract portions of DNA from what seem to be incompatible species and create a new being which shall develop and survive. The alien extraterrestrials that created the first humanoids had several abilities related to genetic coding; they could mix, extract, modify and create. Humans see mixture as viable process but do not yet know, as humans once did, how to extract existing portions or to create.

The objective of the extraterrestrial miners and scavengers was remove gold. They copied the DNA of beings already thriving in the environment of Earth and used the patterns to create new DNA which would not require adaptation or modification.

Specific characteristics, such as reproductive genitalia, were left essentially intact as found in several species already and still on Earth. This does not mean the humanoids were just like the source species but rather, the function served its purpose in other animals so there was no need to reinvent the wheel which already rolled well.

Human genitalia were not designed to resemble the ET creators.

The physical form of the first humanoids was not mostly a resemblance to the ET creators; that came to pass with subsequent upgrades or modifications.

*RKQ: Was there emotional love romantic sexual attraction between the first humanoids? And if so did the et visitors have those same sexual feelings between their own male female race?*

C: Yes and no, not precisely.

The alien extraterrestrials did not and do not reproduce in the same way as do humans, so the process of mate selection is far different. The process does not require sexual urge as stimulant to the procedure, and for the alien extraterrestrials, it is a procedure as humans would perceive it, in the case of the creator civilization.

The romantic love and attraction in the new humanoids were somewhat similar to what occurs in humans now, however the absence of social structures made the manifestation of urges to be with another person far different from the rituals which now dominate human societies. Observation by humans of today would consider the process crude, even abusive and lacking in the subjective human considerations of romance, courtship and deference. For example, many females among humans now have been trained through social development to conceal urges, preferences and proclivities which come naturally to them, if the general social perception deems them unfeminine. Many males are expected to display virility as a sign of manhood, yet as all of you know, there are many variations among humans not in accordance.

Such social considerations did not exist, thus approach towards a mate was as often initiated by the female as the male, and the expression of the desire, affection, and lust as part of the reproductive process was as varied among females as males.

*RKQ: Did the original humanoids have spiritual knowledge emotions or growth or were they colder more robotic?*

C: Your question assumes it is cold and robotic to not have spiritual knowledge or emotions. These humanoids were simplistic by what humans would consider complex and otherwise, according to current human custom.

They were not aware of spirit existence, and this has both advanced and waned through several cycles of human existence on Earth, most recently at a perigee. Most humans today are well described as cold and robotic related to understanding of their spiritual nature or even existence of their souls. How many would deny guardians or souls exist, and would laugh off the suggestion humans are accompanied by spiritual beings?

The early, first humanoids employed as workers were not enslaved by any current understanding of this practice. They had no previously developed society and no ability to survive, not initially. They were entirely at the mercy of their creator masters, much as would be a newborn puppy if it could survive from birth without its mother. Unlike current Earth canines adopted as pets, the early humanoids had mental capability no DNA source Earth being possessed. This came from the creator ETs, who intentionally desired this, in order to teach their creations and make them better, more organized independent workers.

There was no parallel, preferred society to which the first humanoids might escape, which is a principle current human understanding of slavery. To enslaved people born into a system of subjugation and ownership, who know nothing else, there must be a surrounding society which specifically does not live in this way and represents a possibility for them, however unlikely. The examples of ongoing slavery in many Earth nations contain this aspect, also.

None of this applied to the first humanoids. They were well treated by their creators, well attended physically and given as much knowledge and understanding as suited their purpose, to work as miner manual laborers.

*RKQ: Did the humanoids have love for their offspring? Did the ET's have any feelings for their creations other than just worker beings?*

C: Yes, as much as have humans now. As we explained in the previous answer, yes. The approach taken by the alien ET creators was a mixture of what on Earth would be an adoptive parent and a teacher.

Now for reader Suds' question:

*RSQ: Do the extant gorilla, orangutan, bonobo, chimpanzee ...so-called higher primate species also harbor the results of these manipulations in their genome?*

C: No. The source DNA was not modified, existing beings were left alone.

*The Committee continues:*

C: We wish to speak to this topic in a general sense, so that the few of you on Earth, and all reading these words, will know the origins of humanity. Your medium and host holds little interest in this subject beyond a mild curiosity, and we say his point-of-view is accurate, yet other views are also equally interesting, if different.

His thinking is, human societies today bear no resemblance to a race of physical beings from which you are all physically descended. Individual human beings, individual persons, have a great deal in common as it relates to the physical origins, however behaviors, customs and social institutions have no resemblance.

The beginnings of mankind were much like a humanoid drone, programmed to learn but without knowledge beyond the basic requirements called instinct. The alien ET creators knew there would be willing soul occupants, ready to assist in the experiment.

The expectation was to create several hundred beings and over a span of several decades, complete the mining work. The beings created were not expected to be able to survive as a growing population; their death rate would outstrip the rate of survival to the stages of reproduction and successful raising of offspring, much as occurs with many species on Earth whose natural environment is disturbed.

Humans moving into areas big cats consider their domain, will cause the felines to abandon the region. They might encounter new areas where they cannot survive and their population will decrease if they remain. Extinctions of species are a permanent, ongoing feature of Earth and many planets. This was the expectation of what would occur, given the environment of Earth and the many animal species already upon it. The first humanoids were not expected to steadily and regularly exceed 2 births per female as required to grow the population. Accidents, injury, disease and infections were expected to eventually claim enough lives to prevent fertile members of the population from either reproducing or successfully raising offspring to similar stages of life.

Once the task of gold extraction was complete and sufficient material removed and taken to the miners' home planet, did the knowledge of what and how come to the miners' fellow citizens. There was concern and even outrage, because the plan had not been discussed, no research had been conducted on Earth to determine what factors were likely to affect the newly created race and what should be done to prepare the people for normal development, not extinction by abandonment.

As a result, a separate delegation was sent to the nearby civilizations in the Sirius, Pleiades, Arcturus, Canopus and other systems, who had traveled to and visited Earth, had great knowledge of the planet and knew what the visitor miners were doing.

Until this point, no harm had come to Earth that would not be more than a few percent of what typical natural disaster would cause, so the Earth neighbors were not concerned. They also had visited worlds and left what amounted to a few furrows of a plowed field, and knew such contacts would not distort or disturb development.

Their reaction when learning of the mental development potential of the beings created, was similar among the Earth star cluster members, as was among the brethren of the alien ET miners to Earth. They were dismayed and even angered because they knew the potential cruelty which might ensue, to no benefit of existing species on Earth or the newly created hybrid humanoids developing on Earth.

An agreement was made among all concerned space travel capable planets in the cluster, that the newly created race would be protected and steadily taught to develop survival ability. The populations, only several thousand in total, was relocated in groups to areas where climate and natural conditions most favored their survival, as they were given instruction and coaching over several centuries, to ensure their growth and survival of the new species.

Along the way, several minor DNA modifications were made because meteor struck Earth and brought contaminated DNA material, introducing certain, chronic diseases and potential into the developing human population. We specifically mean cancer.

This will now raise the question among humans, how? It is simple to understand scientific modification and even creation of new DNA but these are intentional, extremely advanced scientific methods. How could this occur haphazardly, unintentionally?

The answer is, there are organisms humans do not understand because they have never been seen, which integrate their DNA into and with any organisms with which they have contact. These organisms are what humans would consider microscopic and a type of virus, but they are not like viruses which exist on Earth now. The newly arriving ones are long since extinct, their disease legacy permanent.

As this genetic material mixed with existing species on Earth, the DNA effect was a contamination type process, which allowed cancerous conditions to develop in many more complicated organisms. This naturally included humans.

It was not possible to eliminate this without complete extermination of many species. Efforts were made to improve the created humanoids, and the effects of these changes resulted in the humans now common across Earth.

After several centuries of close monitoring, following close instruction, teaching, leading and assistance throughout, all concerned extraterrestrial worlds agreed there would no longer be contact which might disturb or distort humanity.

Where humans would invite extraterrestrial contact would be permitted and this has been common. The invitations were accepted based on the observations of human societies and attitudes they understood would be displayed.

This has risen and fallen in favorability and is currently at a low but quickly rising level. Increased attention has been given to Earth through the Industrial Revolution and mankind's discovery of what is now considered modern chemistry, physics and the use of electricity.

To the detriment of mankind, humans successfully deciphered the purpose of a device they encountered in a crashed alien ET scout ship. From this device humans learned to split atoms and create a bomb. This development, unexpected along the course of scientific discovery humanity had followed for approximately two centuries prior, has brought great attention and scrutiny to Earth. Humans are almost completely unaware of this, by design and intent, however it is what prompted the initial and ongoing contacts by alien extraterrestrials since the 1930s.

Alien extraterrestrials have explained to many world leaders, the existence of energetic beings looking over and being part of them also, just as humans are spiritual energetic beings in bodies.
