Is change consistent or does consistency require change?

Q: Esteemed Committee, in business it's a gospel catchphrase to say, remaining in place = falling behind. Competitors pull ahead. Is everything in human society like this? Is it necessary to always pull ahead in order to survive?

C: Yes but you do not have to try. You will advance, you will expand and you will pull ahead, whether you try or do not.

Q: Okay, let's all sit back, lie down or just give up, 'cause change she's a coming...

C: Correct.

Q: Why is becoming hungry & homeless good? That's what'll happen!

C: Experience.

Q: Here we go, back to the "pursue positive, avoid negative" theme all humans follow.

C: The examples, alternatives and options for positive & negative are endless; never would any human become bored, which requires an active choice to achieve.

Q: You mean boredom is a selection, a decision?

C: Yes, a selfish one.

Q: Why?

C: It occurs because of refusal to engage. Circumstances imposed which a person cannot control, such as hospitalization for severe medical treatment, are not boredom. These circumstances are frustration caused by involuntary removal of preferred patterns of thought and behavior. To complain of boredom means denial of what exists right in front of the complainer.

Q: Why does the attempt at, and especially actual achievement of consistency, hold such broad appeal?

C: Predictability is a strong illusion, which compensates for fear of loss. Human incarnation has one broad, sweeping benefit for all souls who select it; the loss of control. Your soul has no such challenge with the natural environment in which you live, in Heaven. Upon incarnation, you encounter the opportunity to buy insurance, because of all the unpredictables which give risk to the perceived need for financial protection.

Financial gain and loss are inevitable, when you spend money you lose it just the same as when you throw it out the window of a moving car. The difference is perceived enjoyment of the outcome. You want the new toy, appliance, trinket, device or object for which you have given away money. If you give away money to the wind, you gain the experience of a breeze.

You humans will say, you can gain the experience of a breeze without money cost incurred.

Do you see the appeal of consistency yet?

Q: Somewhat, please go on.

C: Human survival requires control over threats to it; once vital challenges have been tamed to the degree a human need no longer consider and act in ways to ensure survival—a condition reached long ago for the many of you—the mind can move on, however the need for mental activity continues. This gives rise to boredom in some cases where chosen and in many others, it creates the desire for consistency, for predictability in the new mental processes related to work and social interaction.

This is most often seen as pressure to conform. Military success requires conformity and compliance with coordinated, consistent obedience but also mixes in the need for rapid delivery of new information, and willingness to change course, ideas and methods. The survivability factor kicks in and forces a reset and reconfiguration.

Human work and social interaction do not represent vital threats, but the foundation need for compliance with procedure remains strong among the many a human. Awareness of this characteristic prevents the desire for conformity from becoming counter-productive.

Becoming more clear?

Q: Yes, but please go on.

C: An interesting social compact among humans is the formation of public policy, social control for common benefit. This process necessarily generates authority and the power to apply it to the faithful, to the agreeable or to the compliant.

The desire to exert control, as with many desires, returns pleasure sensations, such as satisfaction. A job well done can be personally satisfying. A basic example is human reproduction, the benefit felt physically in addition to the mental. This behavior leads to survival of the species and drives human behavior nearly as efficiently as hunger, and often more vigorously.

The pleasure derived from observance of, compliance with and obedience to issued commands is of equivalent and often enduring effect upon the issuer. Followers derive sensation of consistency from compliance.

Q: The restrictions imposed because of the current pandemic are related?

C: Entirely. Officials humans choose to confiscate wealth enjoy issuance of new commands, in many cases and examples, the reason the commands are given.

We have noted it is common to refer to the science, as explanation of and justification for certain restrictions, however much existing human science knowledge is intentionally set aside in the process.

The orders to close business, confine people to homes and to remain within certain distances of them, will at best delay propagation of a virus, which is precisely what occurs now. The distribution of the virus can be slowed but this is only a delay. This effect has been widely

observed with the study of many epidemics, now pandemics because of world travel, but does not inure to the benefit of current control desires.

Q: The idea we can get the disease under control is popular and widely believed.

C: This requires a sober consideration of control and what it means. What impartial criteria can be applied? Are humans going to require every human be tested for every potentially serious disease which exists? No viral disease has been eradicated since they were identified when viruses were discovered. Many of the diseases remain impossible to cure once contracted. Even the preventions for some viral diseases require a vaccination with live viruses, and side effects do sometimes occur to recipients.

At no time heretofore in the current human civilization were humans given to a reaction we now observe develop, and we say it occurs because of awareness, fear and change.

Q: What has changed to create the current, unprecedented condition?

C: Mass awareness without correspondening information.

Q: Why don't we have the information?

C: You do, however not everyone is interested in it. The topic of face masks is an example; how many regular users of them know the percentage of exhaled air which escapes? This information will demonstrate why the use of one is valid but for a few minutes of protection to others, for a contagious wearer. Protection provided to the target is far less; what you do not inhale will settle upon your eyes.

No matter how severe the testing, restrictions, face devices and other measures implemented, this only slows and delays the inevitable; the virus will remain active in some people. This is precisely what occurs with many viral infections afflicting humans and animals since the beginnings of human existence.

C: The ability to tell you things, to proclaim safety the objective then reap the psychological pleasure, these are fading as you read these words. The addict is rarely happy to face forced withdrawal of the addiction substance; you all know well from treatment plans that resolution comes from acknowledgement by an addicted individual. Only once this acceptance and acknowledgment happen, can an addicted person proceed with a good chance of success.

Behavior patterns and therapy reveal this for many a psychological circumstance.
