## The Matrix

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Coming from Latin and surviving unchanged into several languages, in both spelling and meaning, the word is defined by *The American Heritage® Dictionary of the English Language*, *5th Edition*, as:

- A situation or surrounding substance within which something else originates, develops or is contained
- The womb
- The formative cells or tissue of a specialized structure such as a hair, a finger or toenail, a claw or a tooth.

I consider it a buzzword in New Age circles, but is it typically defined? I don't know how many people automatically know its dictionary meanings; it isn't a word I've heard used much in spoken English. When & where I have, it refers to a grid, sometimes two dimensional, sometimes three. In Spanish it's used more often, almost always to mean "womb". Does any other reader here who uses another language, use or hear it with any regularity? I know we have a good collection of languages here, including French, German, Portuguese, Dutch, Tamil, Spanish and Hindi to name but a few...

What the heck do I know? Let's ask The Committee...

- Q: Esteemed Committee, may I inquire about the New Age buzzwordy status of the word "matrix"? Why would it be considered such?
- C: General human awareness of universal structure is unknown; humans instead perceive merely Earth's structure.
- Q: Did humans ever once widely understand the matrix of the universe?
- C: Yes, which ended within generations of the demise of Atlantis.
- Q: Why don't extraterrestrial Visitors-To-Earth re-inform us?
- C: Not necessary, the humans who accept the existence and presence of Alien ETs already understand what the matrix of the universe is; the remainder of mankind would never allow the information, because at this point in human history, most humans would run away screaming, paying zero attention to information offered. As all readers here already know.
- Q: Please describe the matrix, if you could.
- C: The easiest first image we suggest is a three-dimensional cube.

## Q: Is this a good example?



- C: Yes, this picture shows a portion of the matrix, which all views of it provide. The entirety of the universe, or the matrix, cannot be perceived at any one position, because the observer is always a participant, always a part of the matrix. Backing away is impossible.
- Q: How does mathematics relate to the matrix?
- C: Numbers indicate position, both fixed and rates of change; all human mathematical study is of the matrix.
- Q: What about the human movie by this same name, from 2½ decades ago; did it accurately depict the matrix we are now discussing?
- C: Yes, in parts of the movie it did.
- *Q:* Which parts?
