

The Spiritual Journey

Has anyone heard this phrase before, spiritual journey? (*Veillez excuser mon sarcasme*, as the French would say [even a few Canadians] but I enjoy the good-natured variety). I recall the posts of a few time units back, dealing with buzzwords; I believe “spiritual journey” is within the jurisdiction of buzzword.

- What’s a spiritual journey?
- Is anybody planning to embark on such travels?
- Are we on such an adventure already?

I turn to The Committee for input.

Q: Esteemed Committee, it’s easy to understand what is meant by spiritual journey when the term is offered up, but what does or can it truly mean?

C: All humans embarked on a spiritual journey, as any human might define or understand this phrase, at the point & moment the decision is made to incarnate as a human. No human can decide to embark on a spiritual journey once born as such; you do this as your soul, which you never cease to be.

Q: Obviously it means increased awareness, but of what?

C: That which you have temporarily concealed, set aside, hidden or forgotten.

Q: Why the heck would anybody with great hopes, benevolence, wonderful intentions and desires, seek to conceal or hide good things?

C: Close your eyes and listen with your mind.
